

4 STATES 4 PLAY – RULES TO LIVE BY

(Or at least convincingly pretend to)

OB SHOTS

No provisional balls are allowed during the yearly trip, as we do not play stroke-and-distance. Instead, a one-shot penalty is taken from the spot where the ball went out of bounds.

GIMME PUTTS

Anything inside **2 feet** is good... unless it's for **birdie**. Birdies must be earned — no charity tap-ins.

And just to be clear, a gimme counts **only for that stroke**.

If you're putting for a 4 and leave it short, congrats — that's a 5.

Creative math will not be tolerated.

WINTER RULES

Lift, clean, and place **within 1 foot** (except greens or hazards), no closer to the hole. A hazard is defined by a red, yellow or white marker. If you're playing the ball from the hazard, you can NOT ground your club.

BREAKFAST BALLS & MULLIGANS

One free **breakfast ball** on the first tee — no judgment. Each player will get 2 mulligans per round to use. Scorer of the group must track these.



THE 4-OVER RULE

If you're **4 over** and still hacking away... pick it up.

Time for the **Walk of Shame**.

This one's named in honor of our founding father of futility — **Andy**.



SANDBAGGER WATCH LIST

Beat your handicap by **5+ strokes**? Congrats — you've earned suspicion and a **2 stroke handicap reduction**.

Do it twice? Another drop.
